Attached is my troop's **\$250.00** (Woodruff) deposit for my 2009 Summer Camp Reservation. This **\$250.00** will be credited to my camp fees when we attend camp. Reservation Fee for Bert Adams units is **\$100**. **Note: I am aware that this is a non-refundable deposit if my unit chooses to cancel their reservation.**

Payment Information:

1. We will pay by **February 1, 2009** a reservation payment of **\$70.00** per Scout for the above number of campers. We understand that the council camping committee can only assure and prepare the number of spaces for which payment has been received. **Note: Access to the Program Website will not be possible if this February 1st payment is not made.**
2. By **May 1, 2009** we will pay an additional **\$80.00** (total \$150.00) per Scout for the above number of campers. It is requested that unit leaders pay their total fee by May 1st.
3. The balance of your camp fees are due 10 business days prior to your Sunday arrival date at camp.
4. The \$150 per scout deposit is part of the camper's total fee, but is not refundable. The \$150 per scout deposit may be transferred from one scout to another.
5. Each unit will be permitted **two (2) free leaders**. All other leaders will be expected to pay a leader fee. **Note:** The camper and leader fees for 2009 Boy Scout Summer Camp will be advertised in late September 2008.
6. **No-Show Scouts:** If you have "No Show" Scouts at your 2009 Summer Camp Check-In, that vary significantly from your pre-registration number, your unit may be subject to a \$100 fee per "No-Show" Scout. Please keep us posted with your current participation numbers.

Note: Campsite Assignments:

Many factors go into assigning campsites during summer camp:

1. The most popular sites are requested by more troops than will physically fit into them.
2. The size of the troops coming to camp must be evaluated. Because of the terrain at camp, tent platforms are used. Each campsite has a specific number of tents. It is possible to put a few "temporary" tents in sites, but these tents are usually not preferred by either scouts or adults. There are several sites at camp for very large troops – those with 70 or more attending.
3. Medical needs sometimes dictate that a troop occupy a certain site. Some scouts and adults must be near electrical outlets to power medical equipment or near smooth trails to accommodate wheelchairs. Only certain sites meet these criteria.
4. Finally, all troops should expect to be sharing their campsite with at least one – if not more – troops.
5. Because of the above factors, and more, units will be assigned to the best available site.
